Dr. Todd McCracken attained his BS and DVM degrees from Kansas State University. After graduation in 1993, he spent a short time as a mixed animal practitioner in Illinois, gaining experience with large-scale production facilities. Electing to return to the Kansas City area, he pursued an emphasis in companion animal medicine, joining a small animal practice as a general practitioner for 6 years. During that time, he also owned and operated a critical care facility for 2 years. He then became a Chief of Staff and Hospital Director in a multi-location companion animal hospital, where he broadened his management focus, opening a hospital in the Kansas City area, in 1998.

He became an industry veterinarian for Fort Dodge Animal Health in April of 1999 as a manager in the Professional Services division, having primary responsibilities and emphasis in the companion animal technical support arena. In April of 2001, he was promoted to Manager of Corporate Accounts, providing technical support for one of Fort Dodge Animal Health's largest companion animal corporate accounts. Following the acquisition of the FDAH assets by Boehringer Ingelheim in 2009, Dr. McCracken served as a technical resource for corporate accounts. In 2012, he became a Senior Professional Services Veterinarian for the North Central Region, traveling the country to provide educational support to private practitioners and pet owners. He joined Ceva Animal Health in April of 2017, serving as a Veterinary Services Manager for the North Central Region.
